

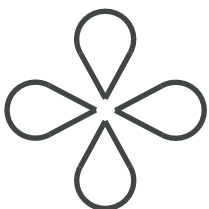

pewter necklaces on nylon coated steel thread



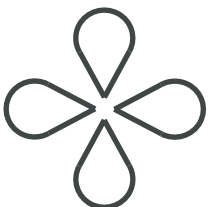

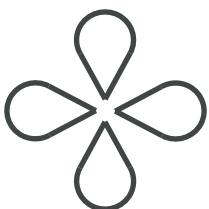

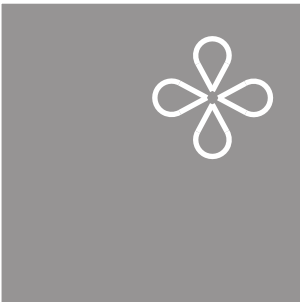
